Clark's Tree ⇨ 0.1 mi.

Chautauqua ⇨ 1.0 mi.

Basalt Monolith ⇨ 1.8 mi.

Bolstad Arch ⇨ 2.0 mi.

Grey Whale ⇨ 2.4 mi.

17th St Trailhead ⇨ 3.2 mi.

Seaview Trailhead ⇨ 3.6 mi.

Red Lake Trailhead

The trail is relatively easy and flat from the northern terminus to Beard's Hollow. The trail gets more challenging at that point, changing

- paved trail
- bridge or boardwalk
- surface streets
- hiking trail
